Personal Independence Payment

I have looked at your award

Dear Mr [REDACTED]

Thank you for asking us to look at your Personal Independence Payment (PIP) claim again. I have now looked again at your award.

On 07 September 2023 there was a change in the law which changed the way we decide PIP claims so I have had to look at whether you could get PIP from 03 May 2023 to 06 September 2023. Then I looked at whether you could get PIP from 07 September 2023.

My decision up to 06 September 2023

- I can still award you the standard rate of £68.10 a week to help with your daily living needs. You can get this from 03 May 2023 to 06 September 2023
- I can award you the enhanced rate of £71.00 a week to help with your mobility needs. You can get this from 03 May 2023 for an ongoing period

My decision from 07 September 2023

- I can no longer award you PIP to help with your daily living needs from 07 September 2023.
- I can award you the enhanced rate of PIP to help with your mobility needs from 03 May 2023 for an ongoing period. This is currently £71.00 a week

Your payments

We will then pay your benefit into your usual account every 4 weeks on a Monday.

Making sure the PIP you get is right

If there is a change to your daily living or mobility needs you must let us know straightaway.

You can find details of other changes you need to tell us about later in this letter.

We have many different ways we can communicate with you.
